Red circle is Hotel Dubrovnik, 4 star hotel only few hundred meters from the venue over the main square: TrgBanaJelačić Square, price: 85euro per night

From the airport Pleso to the center of the Zagreb (where the venue and hotels are situated) you can go by:

- taxi: less then 20 euro

- bus to the main bus station: cca 4 euro, schedule:

- from the Central bus station (Autobusnikolodvor Zagreb) to the centre of the city you can go by:
 - tram: no. 6 direction Črnomerec, and take 5 stations to the main square: TrgbanaJelačića: <http://www.zet.hr/media/189163/6.pdf>: cca 1,4 euro
 - taxi: cca 6 euro
